 When you drop off your child, please check in with the nursery volunteer. We will be keeping track of attendance and parental contact information on an iPad app.

- Please take off shoes and leave them on the bookshelf at the door.
- Please either wash your child's hands in the bathroom before dropping them off or use the hand sanitizer available in the nursery.
- Nursery volunteers will wear face coverings while interacting with children. Children are not required to wear face coverings.
- All toys, tables, and chairs will be sanitized each week.
- Please do not bring your child to the nursery if they have had a fever in the last 24 hours.



Things Happening at First Church

- Safety Plan Update First Church held an informational meeting
 to discuss the proposed Safety Plan on Sunday, October 4.
 Thank you to everyone who participated, asked questions, and
 gave constructive feedback. Consistory discussed the plan at the
 October meeting, and plans to approve a modified version of
 the plan based on feedback at the December meeting. If you
 would like to be involved with the Safety Team, please contact

- Sound System Update we are looking at options to upgrade and replace the sound board and other equipment in the sanctuary. We have put our current equipment to the test this year with the addition of the Praise Team and Facebook Live broadcast. In the last two weeks several different vendors have brought in various options for us to try out. If and when it is time to make a purchase, a quote will be presented to Consistory and then the Congregation for approval. Money for the purchases will come from the Building Improvement and Technology Fund, which was created a few years ago for purchases of this nature.
- Painting Project Update Over the next few months, the
 Trustees plan to organize volunteers to help patch walls and
 paint in the church. There is a lot of work that can be done
 ourselves if we have the right group of people to help. If you're
